



**HMCN (SW/AW/FMF/SCW) Nicholas A. Noviello**  
**Command Master Chief**

A native of Queens, NY Hospital Corpsman Master Chief Petty Officer Nicholas Noviello began his naval career on 19 July 1999 at Recruit Training Command Great Lakes, IL followed by completion of Hospital Corpsman "A" School. He then continued additional training with the Marine Corps at Field Medical Service School in Camp Lejeune, NC.

Master Chief Noviello reported to his first duty station at Naval Ambulatory Care Center Groton, CT in May 2000 where he was assigned to the General Surgery Clinic.

Upon completion of his tour, he reported to U.S Naval Hospital Naples, Italy and worked in both the Multi Service Unit and Surgical Services Department. During his tour, he was accepted into the Preventive Medicine Program and attended "C" School at Naval School of Health Sciences, San Diego, CA. His next tour of duty was to Naval Health Clinic Hawaii, Pearl Harbor, HI where he was assigned to the Preventive Medicine Department. He was selected for the Medical Augmentee Program where he was sent to support 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion 3<sup>rd</sup> Marines from Kaneohe Bay, HI in support of Operation IRAQI FREEDOM in Fallujah, Iraq from January- August 2008. Assigned to Head Quarters & Service Company he supervised Detainee Medical Operations and Preventive Medicine Support in the Al Anbar Province. In February 2010 Master Chief Noviello reported to Naval Mobile Construction Battalion 133 in Gulfport, MS. He served as the Medical Department Leading Petty Officer and deployed to Kandahar, Afghanistan from February-September 2010, conducted a PACOM Humanitarian Mission from March-December 2011 and was then selected to Chief Petty Officer in August 2012. His final deployment with the Seabees was to the Helmand Province of Afghanistan in September 2012. In January 2013 he reported to Naval Health Clinic, Quantico VA, where he was assigned as the Senior Enlisted Leader for the Director for Administration. He was selected to the rank of Senior Chief in June 2015. Master Chief Noviello reported to USS DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER (CVN 69) in August 2015. As Medical Department Leading Chief Petty Officer, he led his team through a combat deployment in support of Operation INHERENT RESOLVE in 2016. He was awarded the General Eisenhower Leadership Award in 2017 and selected for Master Chief in May 2018. He was assigned to the Captain James A. Lovell Federal Health Care Center from September 2018 to January 2021 where he served as the Senior Enlisted Leader for the Chief Medical Executive Directorate.

He is currently assigned to Navy Medicine Readiness and Training Command, Charleston, South Carolina as the Command Master Chief.

His personal awards include Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (four awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (four awards) various campaign and unit awards. He has also earned his Fleet Marine Force Warfare, Seabee Combat Warfare, Surface Warfare and Aviation Warfare Specialist qualifications. He is a graduate of the Navy Senior Enlisted Academy Class 210 (Blue Group) and holds an Associate's Degree in Public Health from Thomas Edison State College.
